

San Antonio Warm Springs Rehabilitation Hospital – SAWSRH Functional Outcomes



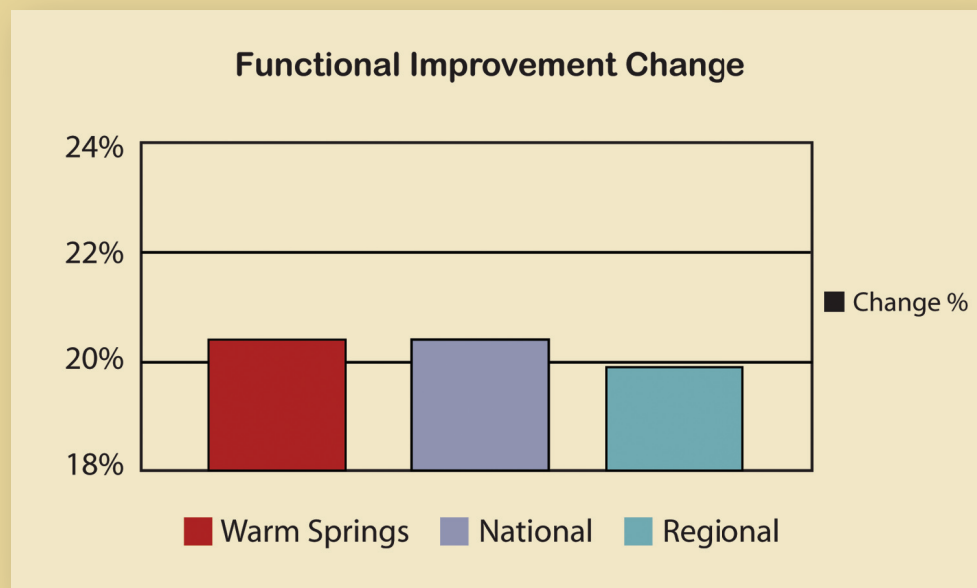
Program Goal

To provide individuals who require physical rehabilitation with an opportunity to develop skills necessary to return to a functional lifestyle.

Program Outcomes

Information below based on eRehabData*

- 1020 persons served during 2005.
- 79% of persons treated at SAWSRH returned to living in their community which was greater than both the National and Regional Average.
- Patients spent an average of 13 days at SAWSRH. Nationally patients stayed an average of 13 days and 13 days regionally.
- The graph below shows the functional improvement of patients in SAWSRH compared to patients in hospitals in the nation and region.
