Guidelines for Admission

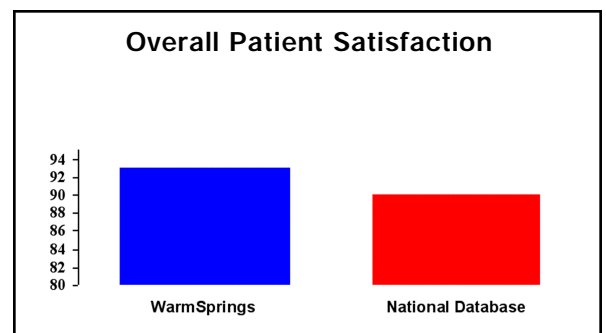
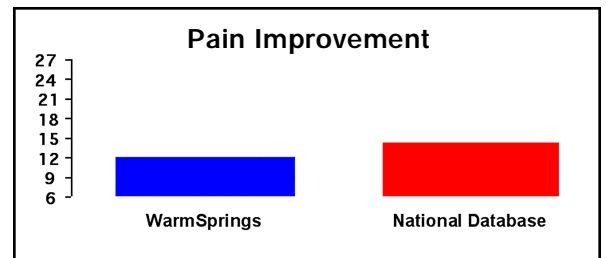
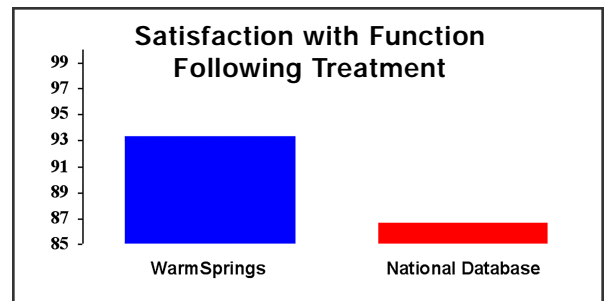
- Individual must be referred by a physician
